¹ Candidate scores for the Multiple-Choice and Hybrid parts of the examination are combined to create an Overall candidate score. This is then equated so that different forms of the examination have the same passing standard, and this equated score is then scaled. There are no separate passing standards for the Hybrid and Multiple Choice parts of the BOC examination.

² The Multiple-Choice and Hybrid scores are reported in raw scores. They do not add to the Overall score. The two scores are combined, equated, and scaled to provide an Overall Scale score for candidates and schools. The number of test takers for each section of the BOC examination is reported separately. Candidates are presented the Multiple-Choice section followed by the Hybrid section. Where there are differences in the number of candidates who completed each section of the BOC examination, this indicates that some candidates did not complete a section. This information may help school personnel identify the need to assist potential BOC exam candidates with their test-taking skills, such as pacing or exam completion.
